



Job Description: Camp Chaplain

Essential Functions: The Camp Chaplain reports to the Camp Director and oversees all interfaith functions of the Scouting program during the summer camping season.

Principle Responsibilities:

- Offer an interfaith worship service if the schedule permits.
- Share information about the religious emblem's programs and Duty to God patch offered in the Council.
- Recruit Staff and Scouts to lead prayers during mealtimes.
- Be available to counsel campers and staff regarding religious needs upon request.
- Develop all-important positive relationships with members of the camp staff.
- Interact with campers on their way to activities. At times, be a participant in the activities with them.
- Visit campsites for unit evening campfires.
- Always be a supportive person to the staff and campers.
- Be a roving public relations ambassador for the camp and local council.
- Serve as God's servant of encouragement and hope to as many campers and staff members as possible.
- Assist in the set-up and takedown of all campsite facilities.
- All other duties as assigned.
