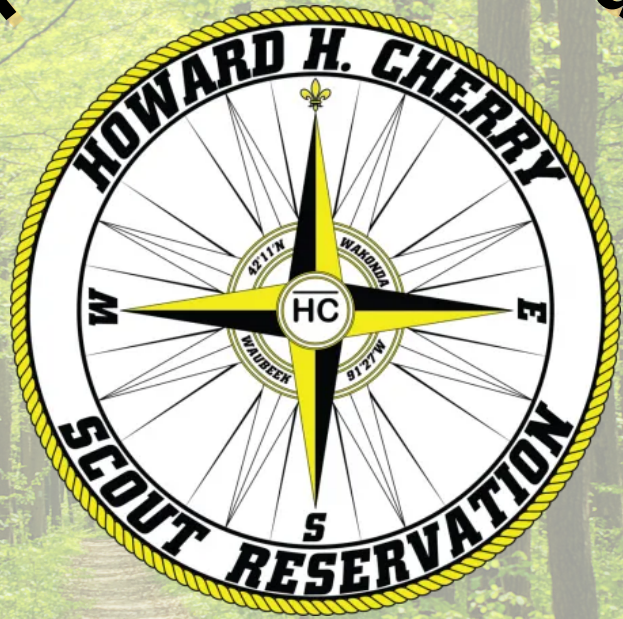

Grades: Entering grades 1-5 in fall 2022

Dates: **June 27 - July 1, 2022 (South)**

Johnson County Fairgrounds, Iowa City

July 18 - 22, 2022 (North)

Cub Adventure Camp is an action-packed 3 day, 2 night camp experience. Scouts are invited to come with a parent, friends, or as a den. Activities are specific to each grade level and designed to not only be fun, but also give attendees a jumpstart on their next Cub Scout rank through a variety of activities and advancements.

Scouts are grouped in dens for their stay and rotate through pre-set age appropriate activity blocks. Fun activities include shooting sports, climbing, swimming, crafts, advancement opportunities, an interfaith chapel service, and organized campfire with camper participation.

Packs/Dens are encouraged to register together to ensure adequate adult supervision for their Scouts.
