2026 National Scout Jamboree Contingent Leader Requirements

NOTICE: Jamboree leadership requires a serious time and financial commitment. Please review the requirements prior to submitting your application.

To qualify as a 2026 National Jamboree Scoutmaster/Advisor, applicants are required to:

- Serve as a Scout/Crew leader (Scoutmaster, Assistant Scoutmaster, Crew Advisor or equivalent youth leader with direct youth contact) for at least one year during the three-year period 2023 to 2026.
- For Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters: Be trained for your Troop position.
- For Venturing Crew Advisors: Be trained for your position.
- Retake Youth Protection Training after August 1, 2025.
- It is recommended that the applicant has completed Wood Badge Training (have received beads) by July 1, 2025.
- Complete Jamboree Scoutmaster/Crew Advisor Training for the combined Illowa/Hawkeye Area Council National Jamboree Committee.
- Commit to recruit and retain a full 36-member Troop/Crew for the Jamboree.
- Strongly encourage prospective junior leaders to attend National Youth Leadership Training.
- Work with the Troop committee comprised of parents of the youth in the Jamboree contingent.
- Commit to attend the entire Jamboree and pre-Jamboree tour from July 16-28, 2017 (Applications not accepted for leaders who cannot commit to the entire Jamboree and pre-Jamboree tour.)
- Commit to hold Jamboree Troop contingent meetings on a regular basis and Pre-Jamboree Trainings during the 24-month period before the Jamboree.
- Commit to attend Council Jamboree Committee meetings.
- Be able to serve as a role model of physical fitness with your BMI in line with the national standards.
- File a current Annual Health and Medical Record form, parts A, B, & C, with the council.
- File "Intent to Serve as a Jamboree Scoutmaster/Crew Advisor" application at the Council Service Center, 4412 N. Brady St., Davenport, IA 52806, or via e-mail to Brittany Simonson, brittany.simonson@scouting.org.
- Complete an interview with the Illowa/Hawkeye Area Council National Jamboree Committee.
- Be approved and formally invited to serve by the Illowa/Hawkeye Area Council National Jamboree Committee.
- Be approved by the Illowa/Hawkeye Area Council Scout Executive (Scoutmasters/Asst Scoutmasters).
